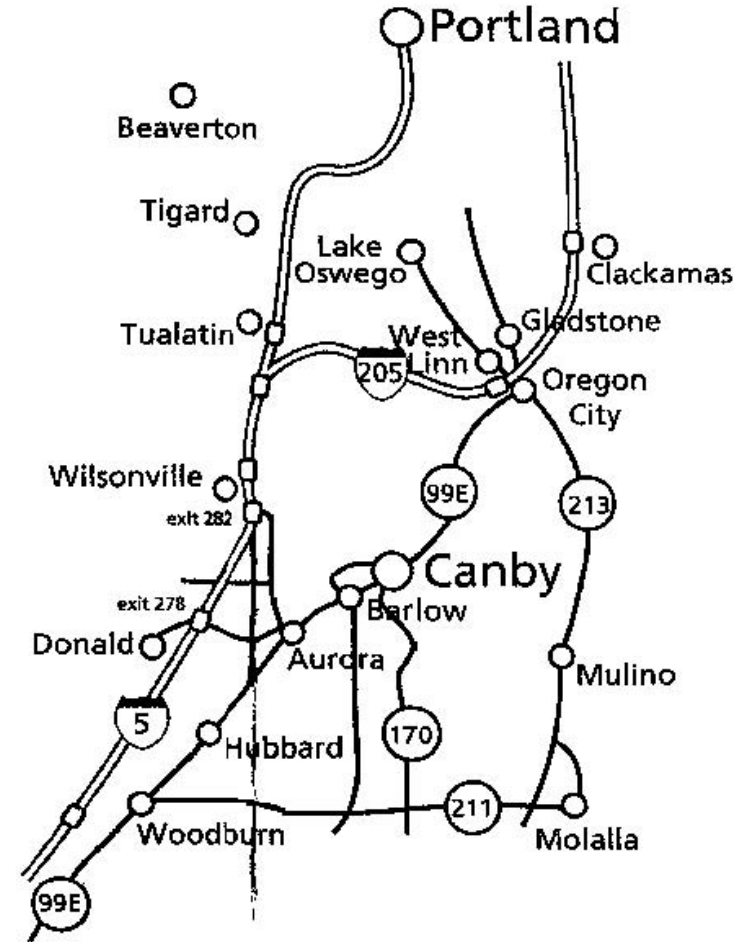

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE
SOUTHBOUND: Take I-205 from north of Vancouver to Exit #9, Oregon City. Follow signs to 99E, which goes through Oregon City to Canby (it's about 8 miles from Oregon City to Canby). You can see the Fairgrounds to the right as you approach Canby. Look for FAIRGROUNDS road signs. OR Continue southbound on I-5 through the Portland metropolitan area and take exit #282, Canby-Hubbard. Follow the directions to Canby and go to the north end of town. Look for the FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show site, which is on the west side of 99E.
NORTHBOUND: Take the DONALD-AURORA Exit from I-5, turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp. Proceed to Aurora (about 1 mile). Turn left onto 99E, go north through Barlow to Canby (about 4 miles). Go to the north end of town and follow FAIRGROUNDS signs to the show (to your left from 99E).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and \$.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6). If the Same Dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry.

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fee of \$25 per check and all items for which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE or Entries Received Without Fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are **NOT** acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed.

Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the above address or telephone 541-935-1672.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary and it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB RESERVES the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE IN THE JUDGING RING to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful recipient of the award. No awards will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

THE SHOW GIVING CLUB OR SHOW SECRETARY and their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or spectators or any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child. The welfare of an exhibitor or spectator's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor or spectator. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors or spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against the Greater Portland Dachshund Club, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Class. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

Master Class. This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing to the Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship Class at this show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 816-3776.

Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

THIS IS A "SCOOP YOUR OWN SHOW."

Ring Steward will hold your dog if you are in the ring.

You are required to clean up after yourself and your dog.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY ANIMALS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.

Dogs in soft crates must not be left unattended.

Absolutely no Flexi-leads or Long lines allowed anywhere on the show grounds
